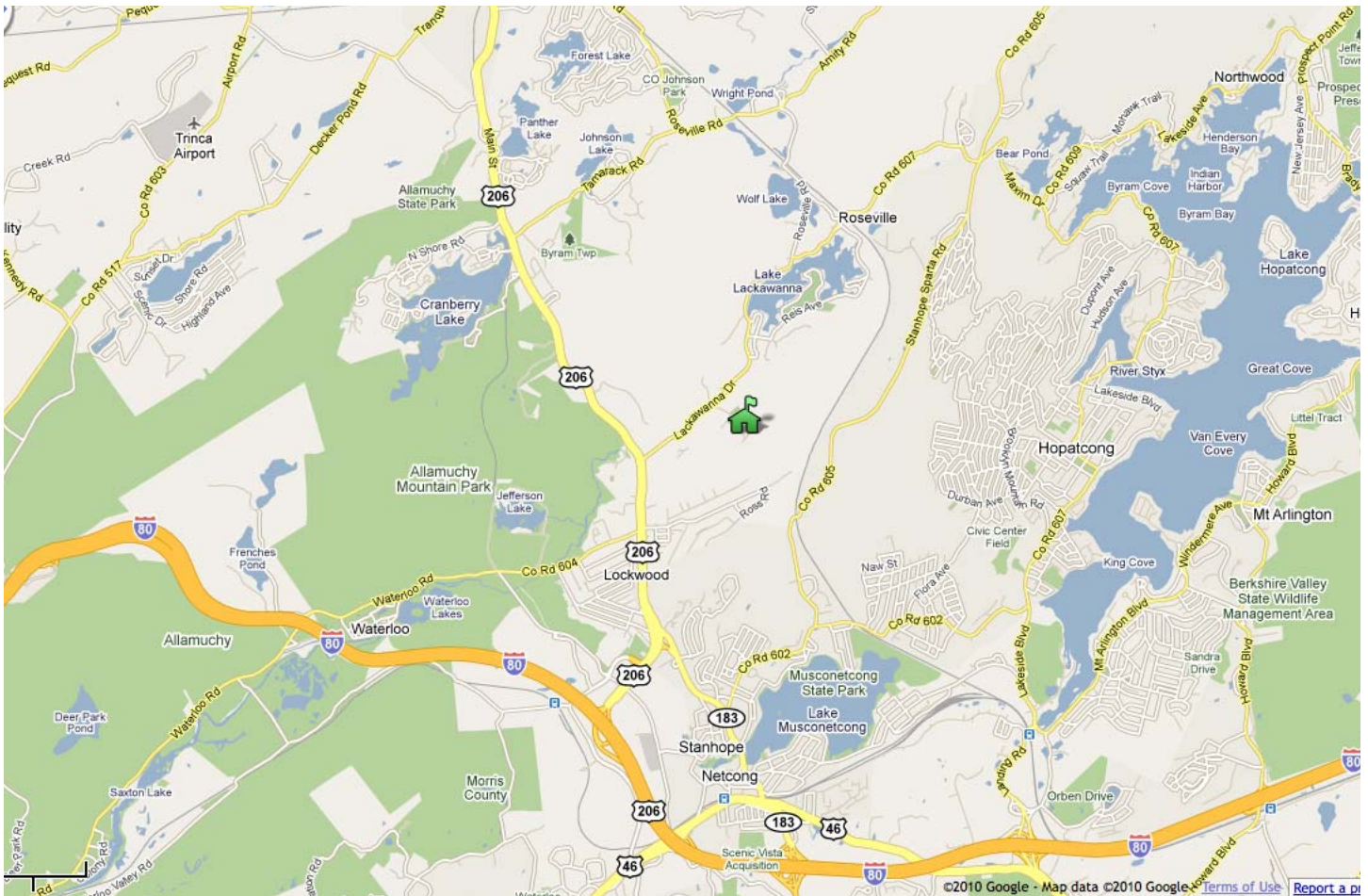

Directions to Intermediate School Library Annex, 12 Mansfield Drive, Byram Township, NJ

If you are using GPS, coordinates are : 40.93499, -74.704907. That will place you at the steps to the Library entrance.

From the south/east via Routes 80 & 206

Take exit 25 off Route 80 West and merge onto US-206 N toward Stanhope/Newton. In approximately 2.3 miles, after passing thru two signaled intersections, turn right at the third signal onto County Rd 607/Lackawanna Dr. (Barones/Lockwood Tavern on your left, Lakeland Bank on the far side of intersection on your right). In approximately 0.7 miles, after passing Wild West City, turn right at Mansfield Dr and proceed for approximately 0.3 mile to the Byram Schools complex. The Intermediate School is on your right. Turn right into the parking lot, and proceed towards the far end of the lot. The Library Annex entrance are at the far end of the lot. Follow the signs once you are in the building.

From the south/west via Routes 80 & 206

Take exit 25 off Route 80 East and merge onto US-206 N toward Stanhope/Newton. In approximately 2.3 miles, after passing thru two signaled intersections, turn right at the third signal onto County Rd 607/Lackawanna Dr. (Barones/Lockwood Tavern on your left, Lakeland Bank on the far side of intersection on your right). In approximately 0.7 miles, after passing Wild West City, turn right at Mansfield Dr and proceed for approximately 0.3 mile to the Byram Schools complex. The Intermediate School is on your right. Turn right into the parking lot, and proceed towards the far end of the lot. The Library Annex entrance are at the far end of the lot. Follow the signs once you are in the building.

From the north via Route 206

Take Route 206 S past Cranberry Lake, down Cat Swamp Hill to Byram Plaza (on your left) and turn left at the signal for County Rd 607/Lackawanna Dr. (Barones/Lockwood Tavern on your right, Lakeland Bank on your left). In approximately 0.7 miles, after passing Wild West City, turn right at Mansfield Dr and proceed for approximately 0.3 mile to the Byram Schools complex. The Intermediate School is on your right. Turn right into the parking lot, and proceed towards the far end of the lot. The Library Annex entrance are at the far end of the lot. Follow the signs once you are in the building.
